

Jesus Teaches: Parable of the Wedding Banquet

Lesson Focus: **God is Never too busy for Us**

Scripture Reference: **Matthew 22: 1-14**

Spark Story Bible Pg. 304

GATHER

Check In with your High & Low for today/this week.

In this lesson, we're going to hear about dancing and a big meal called a banquet.

Question: What kinds of foods do you like to eat at a big meal like a banquet?
What was the biggest, best party you've ever attended?

STORY

**Dear Jesus, Thank you for inviting me to your party!
Be with me, as I learn about you. Amen.**

Read the Parable of the Wedding Banquet told by Jesus. You can find this in the Spark Story Bible on Pg. 304-305 or look in the NRSV Matthew 22:1-14 or listen to the story online.

In our story, some of the guests did not come to the wedding banquet. Why? Luckily for us, God is never too busy! **God hears us every time we pray and listens anytime we want to talk.**

RESPOND

Draw a self portrait of yourself.

When you look at the completed piece, know that God is never too busy for you!

Invite your household to follow you in a "**Follow the Leader**" style **dance**. Pick one person to be the leader in front or at the front of the line (if you decide to do a parade) and pick a dance move for others to copy and follow. Create a streamer stick to add to your movements (side to side, spinning around, floor to ceiling, etc.). Pretend you're on the way to a wedding as you march around the room!
