

Lesson Focus: Happy Birthday Jesus

Scripture Reference: Luke 2:1-20 Spark Story Bible Pg. 212



Check In with your High & Low for today/this week.

Christmastime often gets very busy, so we're going to balance that with a little bit of silence today. Close your eyes. Pause. Take a deep breath. Pause. Now hold your hands and arms as if you were holding a baby. Pause. There will be silence during the prayer to reflect on God's gift to us, Jesus.

Dear Jesus, thank you for coming to us and being our gift. (Pause for 20 seconds.) Teach us to see and hear you as the shepherds did at your birth. Amen.

- 4) The interior pages can be used to tell the Christmas story. Use words, images or both.


Tip: Break the story into six parts.


A sample book might look something like:


