The meeting was called to order by Vice President Carmen Nuland at 6:36pm. Devotions and prayer were led by Pastor Joe.

Motion was made by Beth Meunier to approve the February Council minutes; the motion was seconded and passed. Louise Janke made a motion to approve the February treasurer's report; the motion was seconded and passed.

Old Business:

Kitchen remodeling is progressing. Marilyn Reedy has contacted the manufacturer regarding the heating element in the dishwasher not working.

New business:

A motion was made by Kathy Meunier that Carmen Nuland be appointed as council president. The motion was seconded and passed. This leaves an opening for vice president and the Executive Committee will address this.

The executive committee will name a council liaison for the kitchen remodeling project.

MomCo leadership requests a start date for when donations for the April 6th thrift sale can be dropped off. Gary Meunier will ready an outside shed for drop off to begin March 26th.

There is one confirmation student going to weeklong Bible Camp this summer and 2-5 going to day Bible Camps. A notice will be placed in the take home sheets and Tidings offering the opportunity for members to donate camper scholarships. The full cost for weeklong camp is nearly \$700 although there are subsidies from the camp to bring it down to \$450.

Bonnie Jacobs from Outreach notes that her committee organized 24 Easter bags for the Food pantry as well as a \$30 gift certificate. Four Hundred cookies were delivered to LuMin Campus ministry in LaCrosse.

Pastor Joe reports included that he has made 4 visits this month. Interviews for the custodian position continue. Lenten soup suppers have been well attended and attendance has increased for the Lenten service compared to last year. He enjoyed his short vacation for the Birkie.

MomCo report included that they had speakers on the "The Second Mile Marriage" and age-appropriate chores for youngsters.

We reviewed the 6 focus areas or "pillars" for our congregation as developed by the Strategic Planning/Visioning Committee: Welcoming Culture, Engaging Worship, Inspiring Faith Formation, Healthy Finances, Empowered Leaders, and Joyful Outreach and Service

We reviewed the duties of the council person on call while the minister is on vacation.

The next meeting will be April 16, 2024.

On April 6th, we are pleased to say that we had a very successful garage sale bringing in a little over \$3,000. MomCo will be donating 10% of these proceeds to the Zion's kitchen remodel and 10% to the Summer Lunch Program at Cance park. The rest of the proceeds will go towards purchasing supplies and covering most of our childcare expenses for Momco for the upcoming year. We are very thankful for all of your support and help with this garage sale again this year. Thank you so much for allowing us to use this space, especially during the major construction project. Not only was MomCo able to benefit from these proceeds, but the Blair Community Center, who ran the bake sale, also made \$1000 to help fund their community activities for seniors. It was definitely a blessing for all who were involved.

On April 17th, one of leaders, Janelle, presented a curriculum called "The Birds and the Bees". This video series lays out some helpful tools and connection points for families to be able to talk about sex in helpful and constructive ways. We received so much incredible feedback from our moms on this one as there was a collective sigh of relief in the room stating, "Talking about sex with our kids doesn't have to be hard or scary." MomCo also had the funds to purchase this curriculum for our moms, we hope that it can be a tool that arms families with success as they help each of their children navigate this tricky topic while they grow.

We will be heading into our final month of Momco, for the 2023-2024 year, please be in prayer for us as we close out this year with our moms as well as gear up for what is to come in 2024-2025.
